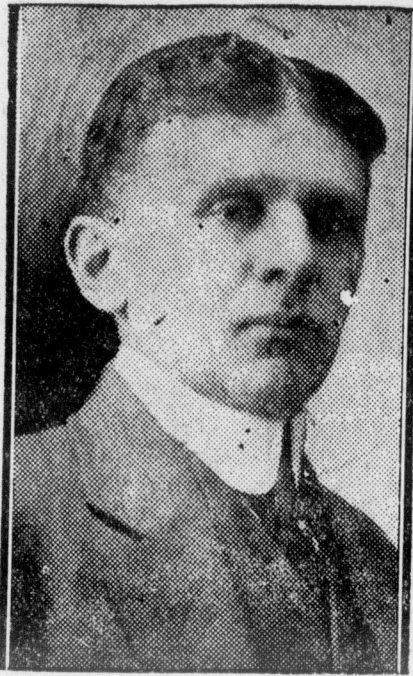


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If re-elected my policy will be to ensure the best possible results for the **MASSSES** and not to serve **ONLY** the **CLASSES**.

We therefore recognize with pride the splendid spirit with which our co-workers and benefactors have entered into this matter with us and for which we desire to express our sincerest appreciation and gratitude.
