

NEW YORK, June 10 .- Groups of men reperesenting U. S. business inwith Leonid Krassin, soviet minister of trade and commerce, and will travel to Canada to discuss trade matters with him, according to Major William Sweet, who has just returned to the United States after a business trip to the countries of Central Europe.
