Grain and Produce.

The grain market to day was steady and firm all over. This was true of both local and foreign markets and in all classes.

There was a slight advance in wheat both at Chicago and New York, as well as in Toronto. On call this morning 80½ was bid for red winter on the track and 79½ for No. 2 spring on the track. Dealers find wheat hard to get, and some of them are reported to be rather in a corner to cover their deals.

The continued briskness in the barley trade is most surprising. There is twice the amount in store now at bawego that there was this time last year, and still the price keeps up and the demand is as brisk as ever. Heavy shipments are being made, though some of the hanks think the contrary.

The Chicago stock yards report receipts of hogs to-day estimated at 28,000, official yesterday 25,82½, shipments 10,63½, left over 10,000.
