REGISTRATION OF VOTERS

UNDER MANHOOD SUFFRAGE BY THE RECENT LEGISLATION.

Summary of the Provisions of the New Act for Purging the Lists—Matters of Importance to Intending Voters—How the Courts of Registration Will be Held.

Owing to the many difficulties hitherto experienced in the way of obtaining a reasonably pure voters' list for elections for the Legislative Assembly for this province, and more particularly in regard to cities, the Attorney-General has introduced a bill to amend the Act of 1894, and to apply it to Toronto, and to S. Thomas conditionally as specially provided, and to all other cities at the date of the coming of the present session.

In order to understand the working of the Act, which is somewhat complicated, it will be necessary to refer to the practical operation of it, leaving the many legal questions to the lawyers and courts to determine.

WIMAN TO BE TRIED MONDAY

For Forgery Two Checks for \$5000 and \$2500—The Case Will be a Rattle Royal Legal Light.

NEW YORK, May 21.—A trial of more than usual significance and importance, and which will concern all the commercial and financial circles of the United States and Canada, as well as many capitalists in Europe, will be commenced on May 28 before Judge Barrett in the Court of Oyer and Terminer.

On that day Erastus Wiman, a well-known capitalist and railroad magnate, known as the "King of the Erie," will be charged with the forgery of two checks for \$5000 and \$2500, drawn by R. G. Dun & Co. of the Mercantile Agency Association of 34 Broadway.

The trial promises to be an unusually interesting one from more than one standpoint.

Wiman was generally credited to the publication of light on the method and conducting of the mercantile agency business.
