Granberry Culture. Cranberries will probably bring \$5 per crate before Christmas in the American markets. The crop is a failure on many bays, owing to the small and to worms. The entire crop of New Jersey is estimated at 80,000 bushels, against 127,014 bushels last year.

Apple Report, 1882. Looson, E. C., Nov. 3, 1882. Dear Sir,—Of direct imports of apples to London, from the States or Canada, there have been none this season and only a few small parcels sent up from Liverpool. The only factor therefor, has been the import here, during the last week or two, of about 300 tons of apples from Giron (north of Spain) part loose, but most of them in cases, some of which containing about 1 cwt. 1 qr. and 6 lbs., net of fruit, packed in 100 lbs. per case common sort, and 17c. to 24c. for the best kinds. Other cases, about 2 cwt., obtained 15c., 17c. and 22c., being mostly of common quality. There are, it is said, some 1000 to 1500 tons of these apples that are sent forward, but they are soft kinds and have not much flavor; some look well but they are wanting in quality.
