Failure of J. B. Reed and Sons.

As intimated in our last issue, the firm of Messrs. J. B. Reed & Sons, extensive furniture manufacturers in this town, has assigned for the benefit of creditors, with liabilities aggregating, at a rough estimate, about \$100,000, while the assets are said to be insufficient to satisfy all claims, outside of the real estate and household effects. The assignees who have been appointed, after due consideration, and for the purpose of whereby this valuable enterprise may be successfully brought out from its present crippled condition and placed on a sound and substantial basis for future and continued operation. When taken into consideration that this business affords employment to several married men with families, together with many single men, and that the founder, Mr. J. B. Reed, has spent nearly a lifetime in bringing it to its present large proportions, and the difficulties with which he has had to contend in introducing the various machinery necessary, as well as meeting the current expenses connected with the running of so large an establishment, we feel sure that the sympathy of all will be enlisted in his behalf, and that we will express the universal wish of our citizens in hoping that the business may be permanently re-established.
