RULES AND SEGULATIONS.

All horses to be eligible at alosing of entries. Entries for all races close July 24th, 1886, at 9 p. m., and must be addressed to 40 King 8t. west, Toronto. Entrance, 10 per cent. of the purse, and must accompany nomination in all cases. Trotting to be mile heats, best 8 in 6, in harness. Jockeys must appear in proper costume, or they will not be allowed to meunt. Weights for Third race will be announced at 4 p.m. on July 27th, and acceptances by 10 s.m. on July 28th, at 40 King street west, Toronto: And, Spr Fifth race by 9 p. m. July 28th, acceptances by 10 klm. July 29th; at 40 King street west, Toronto. Dominion Rules to govern, except in Toronto Brewers' Purse, in which Jerome Park weights must be carried.




