Majesty to which the Convention applies.

Shall be applicable to any such notification.

Any such accession shall take effect

(b) After the expiry of three years from the date of the coming into force of any accession under paragraph (a) of this Article either of the High Contracting Parties may, by giving a six months' notice of termination through the diplomatic channel, terminate the application of the Convention to any country in respect which a notification of accession has been given. The termination of the Convention under Article 13 shall not affect its application to any such country.

(c) Any notification of accession under paragraph (a) of this Article may intelled any dependency or mandated territory administered by the Government of the country in respect of which such notification of accession is given; and any lotice of termination in respect of any such country under paragraph (b) shall apply to any dependency or mandated territory which was included in the notification of accession in respect of that country.
