

- (d) The sending Party's institution will defray the costs of country-to-country round-trip travel, including transit and baggage fees.
- (e) The receiving Party will defray the costs of travel within its own territory that is indispensable for carrying out the Programme agreed upon by the Parties.
- (f) Per diem allowances will be covered by the receiving Party's institution, and will be specified in each case when the exchange is formally accepted.
- (g) Canada's Department of External Affairs will provide a bank of 30 man-days each year to cover the costs of visits included under paragraphs (a) to (f) above, which have been approved by the two Parties but cannot be funded by another Canadian institution.

### Scholarships

2. In the case of an exchange of individuals who have received scholarships, the sending Party must provide the receiving Party with all the necessary documentation, including the syllabus that the candidates are to study.

Applications for the scholarships offered by the Government of Mexico must be received no later than 30th March of each year at the Mexican embassy in Ottawa.
