The four year course (C) is intended for those candidates for the B.C.L. degree (other than Course B) students) who are have neither graduated nor returned soldiers. It is unlikely that lest Indian students will wish to take this course. Arrangements also exist for the combined study of the LL.B. and B.C.L. courses, but with the details of these I need not trouble you. The great majority of West Indian students would probably wish to take either the B.C.L. (Course B) or the LL.B.

The registration fee in the Faculty of Law is \$5-00, and total fees for the session at present amount to \$87-00, which Sum includes athletics and the Union. The question of raising the sessional fee is at present under consideration. The graduation fee is \$12-80.

In conclusion I would say that it is the earnest desire of the Governors to see the Law Faculty of McGill University develope into a central school of law which shall fully meet the needs of students from all the British possessions in the New World. I should therefore greatly value any suggestions or criticisms from you which would assist the Faculty to render a greater service to the cause of legal education in the Empire, and any counsel which you may feel disposed to offer will receive the most careful consideration from the Governors and from the Faculty of Law.
