

Therefore the Corporation of the Town of Whitby, by the Council thereof, enacts as follows:

That from and after the passing of this By-law, no person shall sink or lay any particular drain or gutter under any side-walk, except by permission of the Council, nor shall such person let out or empty upon the surface of any street or lane, any cellar drain, sink drain, or other drain, so that the water shall flow therefrom into the street or lane, under a penalty of five dollars and costs for each offence, and the further sum of ten dollars for each month that such drain shall be so continued to be let out or emptied as aforesaid, said fine to be collected as in next section set forth.

That any person guilty of any infraction of the provisions of this Act, shall, on conviction before the Mayor, Town Reeve or Deputy Town Reeve, forfeit and pay the penalty in the first clause mentioned, together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of any fine and costs, it shall, and may be lawful for the Mayor, Town Reeve, or Deputy Town Reeve, to issue his or their warrant to levy the amount of fine and costs by distress and sale of the offenders goods and chattels, in default of goods and chattels, whereof to make the amount of fine and costs, it shall, and may be lawful for the Mayor, Town Reeve, or Deputy Town Reeve, convicting, to commit the offender or offenders to the common gaol of the County of Ontario for any period not exceeding thirty days, unless the fine and costs shall be sooner paid.
