8th January, 1862.

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The Clergy Trust Committee beg leave to report.

The Revenue arising from the securities held by this Committee has been received in full for the past year.

The following permanent investments have been made during the year :—

Clergy Trust including the Endowments under

its charge..... \$15,600

Bishopric Endowment..... 6,044

The Debentures which matured during the year and were paid off account for the large amount invested.

The Government of Canada having called in the Municipal Loan Fund Debentures, your Committee had those held by them paid, and the amount temporarily invested at six per cent.

The Rev. Gilbert Percy, L.L.D., having left the Diocese, a letter was received from him accepting the Three Hundred Pounds currency, the amount offered him by this Society as a payment in full for any and every claim he might have
