

CHAPTER XIII.

Section 1. It shall be the duty of every member of the Association to lay information to the Discipline Committee against any person observed by him or her driving a motor to the common danger on any of the public streets or roads of the Province. Provided no complaint shall be considered by the said Committee unless the same shall be in writing over the signature of the informant and shall state the date, time and place of said alleged offence.

CHAPTER XIV.

Section 1. Any member of a Committee that is absent for three consecutive meetings, and fails to state his or her reason in writing to said Committee, his or her name shall be struck off said Committee by said Committee.

CHAPTER XV.

Section 1. These By-laws, or any part thereof, may be suspended, amended or cancelled by the Association by a majority vote at a special meeting called for that purpose.
