1. Section 33 of the Statutes

1. Section 33 of the Statutes  
 of Canada is amended to read as follows:

(3) At least one of the members  
 other than the Chairman and Vice-  
 Chairman may be a member of Parlia-

 a member of the House of Commons,  
 be ineligible for election as a member  
 of the House of Commons.
