PROPOSED RULES FOUNDED ON ABOVE REPORT.

Repeal section 3 of Rule 109, and substitute the following therefor:—A reporter for the Court of Appeal for Ontario. Threejoint reporters for the High Court of Justice for Ontario, and two joint reporters of decisions on matters of practice both in the Court of Appeal and in the High Court.

Repeal Rule 113, and substitute the follow ing therefor:-The salary of the Editor shall be two thousand dollars per annum. The salaries of each of the reporters for the Court of Appeal, and the High Court, shall be twelve hundred dollars per annum. The salary of Council and Faculty of Knox's College, the
