

**101.—Being in Column of Files, Threes, Squads, Etc., at Double Distance, to Resume Column Distance.**

*Resume Column Distance, Close—Order.*—On the word ORDER, the leading file, three or squad, step short; all other files, threes, squads, etc., will continue to march forward until the distance between each file, three or squad, is reduced to column distance, and step short.

*Forward.*—When the rear file, three, squad, etc., gains column distance, "Forward."

**102.—Being in Column of Squads, to Form Double Column of Threes Marching to the Front.**

*Close—Order. Double Column of Threes, Threes Right and—Left.*—On the word LEFT, the senior subaltern will give command, "right column threes right" the junior subaltern commands "left column threes left."

*Threes Left and Right.*—The senior subaltern will command "threes left" and the junior subaltern "threes right."

*Forward.*—When the movement is completed, the Captain General will give the command, "Forward."

**NOTE.**—During the execution of the movement towards the flanks, the colors mark time. When the column advances, the colors advance midway between the columns and abreast of their position when in column.

*Double Column of Threes, Columns Right and Left.*—Or, on the word LEFT, the senior subaltern commands "right column, right wheel," and the junior subaltern "left column, left wheel."
