

An Act to Incorporate the Royal Nova Scotia Yacht Squadron.

(Cap. 107, Acts of 1888.)

Passed the 16th day of April, A. D. 1888.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, as follows :

1. Alfred C. Edwards, W. Henry Troop, James W. Stairs, John E. Butler, Alfred E. Jones, and the other members and associates of the association hereby incorporated, and all who shall hereafter become members thereof, are hereby constituted a body corporate under the name of the "Royal Nova Scotia Yacht Squadron."

2. The objects of the corporation hereby created shall be to promote yacht building and sailing in the Province of Nova Scotia, and to encourage its members in becoming proficient in navigation, in the personal management, control, and handling of their yachts, and in all other matters pertaining to seamanship.

3. The constitution and by-laws of the association by this Act incorporated are hereby declared to be the constitution and by-laws of the said corporation, and the said corporation may from time to time alter, add to and repeal the same, and may make, alter and repeal by-laws to carry into effect the objects of the corporation.
