

Either of the above solutions may be used for bathing the hands and face. The corrosive sublimate solution must be used very cautiously.

N. B.—Twenty per cent carbolic soap may be used for the whole of the body.

**12.** *Disinfection of the Dead.*

Envelop the body in a sheet well sewed up and thoroughly saturated with either of the following solutions:

1. Corrosive sublimate, two drachms in one gallon of water.
2. Carbolic acid, 4 oz. in a gallon of water.
3. Chloride of lime, 6 oz. in a gallon of water.

**13.** *Disinfection of the house or the sick room after death or recovery.*

After the convalescent and the inmates of a house who have been exposed to the contagion have been properly disinfected, they must leave the house while it is being disinfected. If for want of accommodation elsewhere they cannot leave it then only part of the house must be disinfected at one time, into which the disinfected inmates may be
