Laurier Cabinet Did It.

They Are Wholly Responsible for the Establishment of the Apostolic Delegation at Ottawa.
In a despatch from Rome to The Boston Pilot, the reported connection of the Canadian Government with the creation of the Apostolic Delegation at Ottawa is contradicted. The despatch says: "Among other just made is that appointing a Delegate Apostolic to Canada. This is done in complete accordance with the Canadian Government. The precise charges for this most important office is Mr. Diomede Falconio, of the Order of Friars Minors, Bishop of Avignone and Matera, in the Kingdom of Italy. When Mr. Falconio, now Cardinal Falconio, returned from his mission in the United States, it was reported that he would be succeeded by Mr. Falconio. The new delegate is 57 years of age, and is an able and distinguished prelate."

LINKLATER STILL AWAY.

Hence the West Huron Election Trial Had to Be Again Adjourned Yesterday.
Mr. Justice Osler and Mr. Justice Ross sat yesterday morning in the Court of Appeal at Osgoode Hall to try the West Huron election case. But John T. Linklater of Wingham, whose absence previously adjourned the trial, was again not present. Their Lordships declared they would not proceed till he was on hand. The trial was therefore adjourned.

SIX-EYE GETS SIX MONTHS.

"Six-Eye" Dan Thompson was yesterday sent to the Central Prison for 6 months for stealing a cape and breaking into premises of R. Lester, 92 Victoria-street, on a charge of wounding Wesley Williams with a razor.
William Christie was committed to jail for 10 days for stealing a bag of rubbers from the Grand Trunk Railway, and Robert McFadden, who stole some soap from the Grand Trunk Railway, went down for 3 months.
