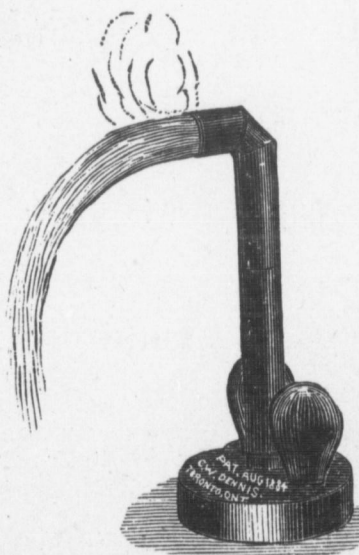


THE MODEL BOSOM-BOARD.

The Illustration shows the Board on the table, with the shirt properly adjusted, in process of ironing. All ladies who do this work know how difficult it is to keep the pleats drawn tight with one hand and iron with the other. This board is of the ordinary length and thickness, formed with a joint near the bottom. The whole is padded, and covered with cotton cloth. The board is placed inside the shirt, and then inside the frame, which is fitted at the neck by a circular head in the frame fitting a corresponding semi-circle in the board. The bottom, or lower bar, is attached to the two sides of the frame by elastic bands, which yield to the pressure of the joint as the board is placed in position, and holds the shirt as in a vice, perfectly smooth and tight, leaving the hands free to adjust the pleats, and enabling the ironer to turn out a well laundered article.
