THIRTY-FIFTH SESSION.

(Being the Eighteenth under the Synod Act of Incorporation of 1874.)

FIRST DAY.

The Synod was convened at London, on Tuesday, June 21st, 1892.

Divine Service was held in St. Paul's Cathedral at 10 o'clock a.m.

The Sermon was preached by the Very Rev. G. M. Innes, M. A., Dean of Huron, from Gal vi., 14.

The Holy Communion was administered to the Clergy and Lay Representatives by the Lord Bishop assisted by the Dean of Huron, and Revs. Canon A. C. Hill, Canon Evans Davis, Canon J. B. Richardson and Canon W. A. Young.

The Synod assembled at 2.30 p.m., in the Chapter House, for business.

The Lord Bishop in the chair.

The appointed prayers were said by Rev. Canon Davis.

The rolls of the Clergy and Lay Representatives were then called by their respective Secretaries, when 77 Clergymen and 66 Lay Representatives answered to their names.

The ballot papers were, in accordance with the Canon, distributed to the members of the Synod as their names were called.
