FALL TERM OF COUNTY COURT

No Criminal Business on
Docket and Only a Few
Civil Cases—Judgment for
Defendant in Liquor Case

The last term of the county court
for the year opened yesterday morn-
ing at the court house at 11 o'clock.
with His Honor Judge Forbes presid-
ing. There were no criminal cases and
the civil docket is short.

The appeal case of The King on the
information of Rankine Grant vs. El-
sworth C. Tutts, was taken up. Grant,
who is a boy of 14 years of age,
was on September 30 last, in the em-
ploy of P. Campbell and Sons, El-
sworth, who is the foreman of the shop,
gave the boy some work to do. Grant
alleges that the defendant assaulted him
and called him a vile name. The
case was tried before the police mag-
istrate on October the third, and
judgment was given for the defend-
ant. The informant appeals.

Yesterday both the defendant and
informant testified, and adjournment
was made until this morning at 10 o'-
clock, when the case will be continu-
ed. D. Mullin, K. C. appeared for the
appellant and E. S. Ritchie for the
respondent.

The naturalization papers of An-
thony Isaac, a Syrian, but who has
resided in St. John for the last 2
years, were read by E. P. Raymond
and ordered filed.

La P. Martin Co. vs. LeBlanc.

His Honor delivered judgment in
the case of La Porte Martin Co. vs.
LeBlanc. This was an action for li-
quors sold the defendant by the plain-
tiff which is an extra provincial cor-
poration and had not paid their li-
cense fee. This was the defence. The
plaintiff claimed that this fact must
be specially pleaded and His Honor
ruled accordingly. Judgment for the
defendant for \$83.80 and costs. A. A.
Wilson, K. C. appeared for the plain-
tiff and J. K. Barry for the defend-
ant. The case of Robert Wilby, as-
signee of Sherriff Ritchie vs. Dunlop
and others, this was an action for
breach of a bail bond. His Honor
ruled that the breach, if any, was not
proved, and not suited the plaintiff.
A. A. Wilson, K. C., G. S. Shaw and
C. H. Ferguson appeared for the de-
fendants and Mr. Mullin for the plain-
tiff. Mr. Mullin will appeal.

In the afternoon the jury in the
case of H. E. Bond & Co. Ltd., of
Toronto, vs. Joseph Moscovitz, a
merchant of Edmonton, returned a
verdict for the defendant.

This was an action for \$324.00
which the plaintiffs alleged was due
them on an order for ready made
clothing given to their traveller by
the defendant. The defendant de-
nied that he gave more than one or-
der and that the goods which he did
give were not of the quality alleged.

The jury retired at five o'clock and
shortly after returned a verdict for
the defendant as previously stated.

The court then arose to meet this
morning at ten o'clock, when the ap-
peal case of the King on the informa-
tion of Grant vs. Tutts will be taken
up.

The non jury case of Alfred E. Mc-
Ginley vs. the Telegraph Publishing
Co., will be taken up in the afternoon.
