

JONES Reg. No. 10351, ex-Cst. Thomas Jones, 87, died July 10, 1997, at Annapolis County, N.S. He was born July 2, 1910, and took his discharge from the Force on June 20, 1948.

KWIATKOWSKI Reg. No. 27724, ex-Cst. Henry Allan Kwiatkowski, 48, died March 30, 1997. He was born October 16, 1948, at Shoal Lake, Man., and joined the Force February 4, 1970, at Brandon. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Kwiatkowski was posted to "E" Division, B.C., where he worked at North Vancouver, Prince Rupert and Kamloops, and then resigned on July 25, 1985.

KYLE Reg. No. 14513, ex-Cst. Walter Lawrence Kyle, 74, died November 17, 1996, at St-Louis, Missouri, U.S.A. He was born September 11, 1922, at Dysart, Sask., and joined the Force May 16, 1942, at Regina. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, Kyle was posted to "I" Division, N.B., namely at Fredericton, Woodstock and Saint John. He took his discharge October 7, 1947, to join the New York Rangers (NHL) hockey team. (See p. 238, Vol. 15 No. 3, *RCMP Quarterly*, January 1950. — Ed.)

LEFEBVRE Reg. No. 41471 (S/2990), Cst. Joseph Pierre Claude Lefebvre, 51, died May 18, 1997, at Moncton, N.B. He was born August 10, 1945, at Sainte-Hyacinthe, Que., and joined the Force as a special constable on January 1, 1986, at Montréal. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Lefebvre was posted to "A" Division, Ont., at Ottawa. He converted to regular member status on October 27, 1989, and on March 15, 1990, he was transferred to "J" Division, N.B., where he served at Caraquet and Riverview, where he was still working at the time of his death.

LEMAY Reg. No. 31553, Sgt. Joseph Lucien Gilles Robert Lemay, 42, died April 30, 1997, at Bogota, Columbia. He was born April 19, 1955, at Montréal, where he had joined the Force May 31, 1974. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Lemay was posted to "A" Division, Ont., at Ottawa. He was subsequently transferred to the following locations: on March 8, 1976, to "E" Division, B.C., at Surrey and Vancouver; on February 15, 1982, to HQ; on June 1, 1988, to "C" Division, Que., at Montréal; on August 8, 1992, to HQ; on December 16, 1994, to "A" Division, where he served in Haiti; on July 3, 1995, to HQ, Foreign Services, namely at Bogota, where he had been posted since July 15, 1996, and was still working at the time of his death. Lemay was promoted to corporal September 20, 1988; sergeant August 31, 1992.

Lemay was awarded the U.S. Army Meritorious Achievement Medal for participation in the Haitian Parliamentary Election process, the UNMIH Certificate of Appreciation and the UNMIH Medal (June 25, 1995).

LUCAS Reg. No. C/1509, ex-C/M William Frederick Lucas, 63, died July 3, 1997, at Regina. He was born December 14, 1933, at Warwick Township, Lambton

County, Ont., and joined the Force as a civilian member on April 30, 1974, at Ottawa. Lucas was posted to HQ, namely at CPIC, and on May 1, 1975, he was transferred to "F" Division, Sask., where he worked at Regina. On June 15, 1980, Lucas was posted to HQ and retired on May 31, 1994.

MACDONALD Reg. No. 31513, ex-Cst. Bruce William MacDonald, 42, died February 27, 1997, at Vancouver. He was born November 13, 1954, at Sudbury, Ont., and joined the Force May 17, 1974, at Vancouver. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, MacDonald was posted to "E" Division, B.C., where he worked at Invermere, Nelson, Castlegar, Cranbrook, Vanderhoof and Prince George, and then took his discharge January 18, 1995.

MCCALL Reg. No. 15270 (S/9497), ex-S/Sgt. Walter William McCall (nee Makowichuk and later called Macall), 68, died March 6, 1997, at Sherwood Park, Alta. He was born March 13, 1928, at Soda Lake, and joined the Force as a special constable at Edmonton, on March 31, 1947. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, McCall was posted to "O" Division, Ont., where he worked at Timmins and Toronto. On September 1, 1948, he converted to regular member status and on August 15, 1953, he was transferred to "K" Division, Alta, where he worked at Edmonton, Manning, Calgary, Banff and Lethbridge, and then retired on March 30, 1972. McCall was promoted to corporal April 1, 1957; sergeant October 1, 1963; staff sergeant April 1, 1966.

MCDONALD Reg. No. 15173, ex-Cpl. Carl Thomas McDonald, 71, died April 20, 1997, at Ottawa, where he was born on February 4, 1926. He joined the Force at Toronto, August 30, 1948, and upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, he was posted to "A" Division, Ont., namely at Ottawa. McDonald was subsequently transferred to the following locations: on June 13, 1950, to "D" Division, Man., at Winnipeg and Sprague; in May 1953, to HQ; in November 1957, to "N" Division, and then retired on June 24, 1968. He was promoted to corporal November 1, 1965.

MERSEREAU Reg. No. 15682, ex-Sgt. Merrill Gordon Mersereau, 67, died June 22, 1997, at Ottawa. He was born April 14, 1930, at Boston, Massachusetts, U.S.A., and joined the Force January 4, 1949, at Fredericton, N.B. Upon completion of training at "Depot" Division, Mersereau was posted to "H" Division, N.S., where he served at Halifax, Port Hawkesbury, Sydney and Inverness; then in July 1953, he was transferred to HQ and retired on January 3, 1973. Mersereau was promoted to corporal November 1, 1958; sergeant May 1, 1964.

NOEL Reg. No. 16206, ex-Cst. Llewellyn Noel, 71, died recently in B.C. He was born September 30, 1925, at Harbour Grace South, Nfld., and joined the Force at Port aux Basques, when the Newfoundland Rangers, where he had been working since May 19, 1945, amalgamated with the RCMP on August 1,
