S. of the Rev. W. Clarke, one of the three first Congregational Ministers that came to Can.; and grands. of James Clarke, Esq., a large landed proprietor in Staffordshire, Eng. B. in Coventry, Eng., 16 July, 1827. Ed. in Eng. M., 1st, 1847, Susan Maria, second dau. of Joseph Vannorman, Esq., of Normandale, (she d. 1853); 2ndly, 1855, Maria, second dau. of Thos. J. Mulkins, Esq., of Simcoe. A Licentiate of Montreal Medical Board, 1847. Was a Coroner for Norfolk from 1847 to 1871. Has been also a mem. of the Town Council. First returned to Parlt., for present seat, at last g.e., A Liberal.—*Simcoe.*
