

An Act to repeal the several Acts and parts of Acts authorizing the establishment and maintenance of Separate or Sectarian Schools in Upper Canada.

WHEREAS the establishment of Sectarian or Separate Schools in that part of this Province called Upper Canada has been attended with evil effects in many parts thereof: And whereas the peace, welfare and good government of that part of this Province require that such Separate or Sectarian Schools should be wholly abrogated and abolished; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: Preamble.

I. From and after the twenty-fifth day of December, which will be in this present year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, the nineteenth section of the Act intituled "*An Act for the better establishment and maintenance of Common Schools in Upper Canada,*" passed in the Session held in the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty's reign,—Also the fourth section of the Act intituled "*An Act supplementary to the Common School Act of Upper Canada,*" passed in the sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign,—And also the Act passed in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled, "*An Act to amend the laws relating to Separate Schools in Upper Canada,*" and known commonly and designated as the "*Roman Catholic Separate School Act,*" shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.
