Foreign Salt may be exported to Newfound-Import Warehoufes in Briftol, Duty free.

faid: Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal. and Commons, in this prefent Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame. That from and after the First Day of July One thousand eight hundred and ten, it shall and may be lawful to and for any Perfon or Perfons within Twelve Months after the Importation and Landing thereof. land from the to take, free of Duty, for the Purpole of immediately exporting the fame in any Ship or Veffel not of lefs Burthen than Forty Tons, to Newfoundland, for curing Cod Fish, Ling, or Hake, to be there caught, any Quantity exceeding Fifty Bushels at a Time of Foreign Salt, from and out of any Import Warehoufe, Storehoufe or Cellar, at the Port of Briftol, in which the fame has been put according to the Regulations of the faid Act made in the Thirty-eighth Year aforefaid, upon giving the like Bond or Security, and under, fubject, and according to the Rules, Regulations, Reftrictions, and Provisions by the faid Act made in the Thirtyninth Year aforefaid, provided, fettled or established, for or in respect of Foreign Salt taken free of Duty for the Purpole aforefaid, from and out of any Import Warehoufe, Storehoufe or Cellar, at the faid Ports of Poole, Dartmouth, Falmouth, and Glafgow respectively.

Regulations provided by 39 G. 3. c. 65. to extend to the Port of Briftol.

II. And be it further enacted, That all and fingular the Rules, Regulations, Refrictions, Provisions, Matters, and Things which are, in or by the faid Act made in the Thirty ninth Year aforefaid, contained, provided, fettled, or established, for or in respect of or relating to the taking from or out of any Import Warehouse, Storehouse, or Cellar, at either of the faid Ports of Poole, Dartmouth, Falmouth, or Glafgow, Foreign Salt, free of Duty, for the Purposes in the faid Act of the Thirty-ninth Year aforefaid mentioned, shall be observed, practifed, applied, and put in Execution. for and in refpect of the taking from or out of any Import Warehoufe. Storehoufe, or Cellar, at the faid Port of Briftol, as fully and effectually to all Intents and Purpofes as if all and fingular the faid Rules, Regulations, Reftrictions, Provisions, Matters, and Things had been inferted and reenacted in this Act, and hereby expreisly enacted for and in respect of any fuch Foreign Salt as last aforefaid.

·From January 1, 1811, fo much of 49 G.3. c.47. as allows Salt to be exported from Europe South of Cape Finifterre, to certain Ports in America, repealed.

III. And be it further enacted, That from and after the First Day of January One thousand eight hundred and eleven, fo much of the Act paffed in the Forty-ninth Year of the Reign of His faid prefent Majefty. intituled, An Act to permit certain Articles, the Growth, Production, or Manufacture of Europe, to be laden and shipped on board Ships arriving with British North American Produce, and Fish taken by Settlers in the British North American Colonies, at any Port of Europe, in order to be exported to the principal Ports in the British Colonies and Plantations in North America, as allows Salt, the Produce of any Part of Europe, South of Cape Finisterre, to be shipped and laden in any Port or Place whatever, in such Parts of Europe for Exportation direct to the feveral Ports in North America, in the faid Act particularly enumerated, fhall be and the fame is hereby repealed.

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
