

add expended during the then past year certified by the Treasurer.

V. And be it enacted, That all deeds sealed with the common seal of the Corporation, and signed by the President or one of the Vice Presidents, and countersigned by the Secretary, or in his absence by the Assistant Secretary, shall be held to be deeds of the Corporation: What shall be deeds of the Corporation. Provided always, Proviso. that the Treasurer for the time being may receive all moneys payable to the Corporation, and grant valid receipts therefor.

VI. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the said Corporation to make By-laws which shall bind the members thereof, and all other parties who shall in writing agree to be bound by them, and to repeal or amend the same from time to time in the manner hereinafter provided; and such By-laws or amendments (except those of the said Society hereinafter continued in force) shall be prepared by the Committee of Management, and submitted by them to a general meeting of the Corporation at which the President or one of the Vice Presidents and at least twenty five ordinary members of the Corporation shall be present, and may at another general meeting to be held thereafter, be adopted, amended or rejected, in whole or in part: Corporation may make By-laws. Provided always, that no such By-law shall have force and effect except in so far as it shall not be repugnant to this Act or to the Laws of Lower Canada; and provided also, that no such By-law, Proviso; existing By-laws continued in force. shall impose any penalty or forfeiture exceeding *fifty shillings*; And provided also, and it is hereby enacted, that the present constitution and By-laws of the said Society, in so far as they may not be repugnant to this Act, or to the Laws of Lower Canada, shall be the By-laws of the Corporation hereby constituted until they shall be repealed or altered as aforesaid.
