

II. And be it enacted, That the said De-
 bentures may be issued in such form and for
 such separate sums, respectively, as the
 Governor in Council shall deem expedient,
 5 and may be issued either to such parties as
 shall be willing to advance money for the
 same, or to parties to whom money shall be
 awarded for compensation of losses under
 this Act, or who shall demand them in ex-
 10 change for Debentures of like amount issued
 under the Act hereinafter mentioned.

Debentures
 may be issued
 in such form
 as the Gover-
 nor in Council
 may deem ex-
 pedient.

III. And be it enacted, That the holder
 of any Debenture issued under the autho-
 rity of the Act passed in the ninth year of
 15 Her Majesty's Reign and intituled, "*An Act*
" to provide for the payment of certain Rebel-
" lion Losses in Lower Canada, and to appro-
" priate the proceeds of the Marriage License
" Fund," may, on any day on which the in-
 20 terest on such Debenture is payable, have
 the same exchanged for a Debenture for a
 like amount to be issued under this Act, and
 the interest then payable on such Debenture
 shall at the same time be paid out of the said
 25 Consolidated Revenue Fund, and the pro-
 ceeds of so much of that portion of the Mar-
 riage License Fund arising in Lower Ca-
 nada as shall not be required to pay off the
 principal and interest of any unexchanged
 30 Debenture, shall form part of the said Con-
 solidated Revenue Fund.

IV. Provided always, and be it enacted,
 That the Governor in Council may, at any
 time, by notice in the *Canada Gazette*, re-
 35 quire that all the Debentures issued under
 this Act be presented at a time certain, and
 not less than six months from the date of
 such notice, for payment of the principal
 and interest thereof in full; and such pay-
 40 ment shall be made accordingly out of the
 said Consolidated Revenue Fund, and after
 the time so appointed no interest shall ac-
 crue on the Debentures which shall not be
 so presented.

Governor may
 at any time re-
 quire all the
 Debentures
 issued under
 this Act, to be
 presented for
 payment in
 full.
