 28Courts of Queen's Bench, when the said
 Act shall come into effect, and to the return
 30of process in such cases, are hereby declared
 to apply to like proceedings pending in the
 32Court of Queen's Bench in the District of
 Gaspé, when this Act shall come into effect,
