

An Act to provide for the running of Side Lines in the Township of Bristol, in the County of Pontiac.

WHEREAS the present practice of running side lines from post to post, has been found to be expensive, uncertain, and unsatisfactory in the County of Pontiac, and it is desirable to adopt a more correct and expeditious mode for the survey of side lines in the Township of Bristol in that County ; and whereas each and every side line of lots in the said Township of Bristol has been always drawn parallel with the boundary line of the Township of Clarendon, and to alter the same to the present system of drawing side lines from post to post would be attended with great inconvenience: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :—

1. The side lines in the said Township of Bristol already run parallel to the boundary line of the Township of Clarendon, shall be and are hereby established as correct, and all side lines in the said Township of Bristol shall hereafter be drawn parallel with the boundary line of the said Township of Clarendon,—anything in chapter seventy-seven of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, or in other Act or law to the contrary notwithstanding.

How the side lines in Bristol shall be drawn.

2. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
