An Act to provide for the running of Side Lines in the Township of Bristol, in the County of Pontiac.

WHEREAS the present practice of running side lines from post to Preamble. post, has been found to be expensive, uncertain, and unsatisfactory in the County of Pontiac, and it is desirable to adopt a more correct and expeditious mode for the survey of side lines in the Township 5 of Bristol in that County; and whereas each and every side line of lots in the said Township of Bristol has been always drawn parallel with the boundary line of the Township of Clarendon, and to alter the same to the present system of drawing side lines from post to post would be attended with great inconvenience: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with 10 the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:-

1. The side lines in the said Township of Bristol already run parallel How the side to the boundary line of the Township of Clarendon, shall be and lines in Brisare hereby established as correct, and all side lines in the said Town-tol shall be ship of Bristel shall be drawn parallel with the houndary line drawn. 15 ship of Bristol shall hereafter be drawn parallel with the boundary line of the said Township of Clarendon,—anything in chapter seventy-seven of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, or in-other Act or law to the contrary notwithstanding.

2. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
