Under an Act, Chan. 139 of 4-5 Rd. VII, the Onterio and Minnesota Power Company (Limited) has been granted the right to construct a dam at Fort Frances, Out., which will raise the waters of the Rainy Tiver about five feet.

As the raising of the waters ro-Cerred to would affect the Indian Reserve known as Wol, general reserve, at the westerly end of Rainy Lake, in the Rainy River District of Ontario, by flooding about eighteen acros of the reserve and demaging certain improvements thereon, the Company has applied to the Department of Indian Affairs for permission to floot the area referred to, and has expressed its willingness to make compensation for any damages done by such flooding.

The undersigned would recomend that the perartment of Indian Affairs be authorised to sell-3. lease the said eighteen acres, or rise grant the right to flood the same, upon such terms as the said Department may decide upon. de plane
