The undersigned begs to submit herewith regulations, in duplicate, adopted on the 4th day of March, 1922, by the Dog Creek band of Indians under sub-section (g) of section 98 of the Indian Act for the establishment of a pound and the appointment of a pound-keeper on the Dog Creek Indian Reserve, No.46, in the Province of Manitoba.

As these regulations have been framed in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Act, the undersigned would recommend that they be confirmed by Your Excellency in Council, one copy to be returned to the Department of Indian Affairs and the other copy to be kept of record in the Privy Council Office.
