The question of having the reserve surveyed was then taken up, and I may say that this is an important matter, the whole reserve wants a survey made, the Council has passed a resolution to have this done, I enclose copy of Resolution the expense in connection with this survey is to be paid from the capital fund of the Band, and \$75 a year taken from the interest money each year to recoup the capital until all is paid it is suggested by the Council that iron posts be placed at all corners and division lines of the lots and also that the Department send Mr Bray or some other Department surveyor to do the work.
