Provisions for them, and of It is with full consont of the Six Hatims allowed you to plant and of at or near ofwego, and to have Sashirage for your attles according to your dosine, and wo shall mark out such a Track Land as shall be newsary for your Mon to raise provisions and Jashirago, but we will hot to pleased if after it is marked out you'd go boyond the Limits that we fix. Gave a Belt of Wampum Brother orlaer you told us that if any attompt be made against the House at Ofwogs we should defond it, we acquaint you that last year when Liberty was desired to Build there, it was told its that the same was built on purpose to do fond and protoct the Six Hations, because it is the Frontier of our Hations, theres. : fore we rely on your performing of thek Fromisos. You told ut also that you heard that we were apprehonsive of that if the Far Indians bought any goods here they would borome door, but that the more Frade thero is the more Goods

will be sont hither and that there is Work enough in England to Supply the whole World, we are von gled to hear this, The Housed at Mwogs is the most convenient place that can be for Trade, it is a place where all the Far Indians must nestaryly pass, we dosine that Goods may be sold some what thousand to us, and that would be a testive to draw all the Far Hatims to us. and join with os, for through choopers of Goods will become Peace and Unity.

You told us Jour boing informed that when the Trench Army, wont op lest Spring against the Far Habions, some Trench Indiahs had boon amongst us to entire some of our young Men to go to War along with them against a Boaco able poople; that you was glad our forming ston refused to go with thom for by those mound those har Judians will become friends to the Dix Hations.

It is how that the French did dovine us to go with thom, but wo refused and rejector their Proposal, because we are convined that the French boars us no Friendship and we have no very great depondences on them for if this Army could they would have subdued the Six Nations, and instead of going against the Topor would have Mastered in whom it was time of Back, for they have made us soverab threathings. You have recommended to us to cultivate a good indonstanding with the Farmy find and and draw thom as much as we can to join with us, its is true we had Wax against this or that Nation, but never have been the first Aggregor, all who have made War with us
