Sir

By the enclosed Memorandum made by Mr Jones of the Crown Lands Department you will perceive that a patent issued to William Wheeler for the East half of Lot 44 in the 2nd Concession of the Burtch Post Brantford containing 75 Acres instead of the North East part of said Lot 50 Acres.

The above error was not discovered till a patent to Miles Coleman for the residue of the lot was called for. The mistake is mainly attributable to Mr Walker who described Wheeler's portion as the East, instead of the North East part. You will therefore apply to Mr Wheeler for the Surrender of his Patent, in order that a correct one may issue to him, and another to Mr Coleman.
