As a first step, it is suggested that a number of copies of each

press release already sent out from the Prime Minister's Office be sent to External Affairs (Dr. Keenleyside). As the work of co-ordinating press releases develops, so will the demand for copies increase, and in all probability it will be necessary to stencil each release. At the present time, the duplicating equipment in External Affairs or in Privy Council is available for our use, and this may serve for the present.

Later we will probably have to obtain a machine for the Information Office.
