The Department of External Affairs are desirous of placing in the hands of their various legations copies of all regulations, orders, press releases, etc.

So far as press releases are concerned, if and when the Departments cooperate by furnishing the Information Office with copies of all releases, it will be a simple matter to see that copies in turn are furnished to the Department of External Affairs for distribution to the legations. As a first step, it is suggested that a number of copies of each press release already sent out from the Prime Minister's Office be sent to External Affairs (Dr. Keenleyside).

As the work of co-ordinating press releases develops, so will the demand for copies increase, and in all probability it will be necessary to stencil each release. At the present time, the duplicating equipment in External Affairs or in Privy Council is available for our use, and this may serve for the present. Later we will probably have to obtain a machine for the Information Office.
