With reference to mining claims situated within the limits of the tract of land at Abitibi Lake, surveyed as an Indian reserve, which were obtained prior to the said survey, I have to say that this Department is willing, in accordance with your desire, that your Department should deal with the said claims, and it will be satisfactory to have an area of land added to the reserve equal to that which may be taken up by the mining claims.

The Indians will be communicated with in regard to this matter and will be asked to state the locality in which they desire to have the addition made and on receipt of their reply you will be again communicated with.
