With Cheque.


Sir,

With reference to the account which you submitted in favour of the Revd Father Dugas, and which is rendered at \$3280 for expenses incurred in connection with the removal of the remains of deceased Indians of the Fort William Band from the old to the new cemetery, I beg to say that it is observed that you state that this is the amount for which Revd Father Le Marche agreed to have the work done.

I have to inform you that before making payment at the full amount the Department desires to have a full report from you in regard to the actual work performed, viz the number of bodies removed, etc. You should also state whether the undertaking in question involved as much work as was anticipated.

A cheque No 3194 for \$2000.00 is enclosed herewith being payment on account. Your report will be awaited.
