



Ottawa 23rd March, 1905.

Sir,

I beg to direct your attention to the concluding paragraph of letter to you of the 26th November, and to inform you that the Department insists upon your complying with the instructions therein contained in regard to depositing daily in the Bank all moneys which you receive on account of Indian lands, etc. The deposit must, as pointed out, be made in every case to the credit of the Receiver General, and the bank certificates forwarded to Headquarters in the manner specified.
