The band of Indians has practically no funds. In the event of it being decided to execute the work suggested by the Engineer funds will require to be especially provided. It is considered that the proposed expenditure is of doubtful utility.

The Indian Agent recommended that the meadow could be improved by clearing away the alder bushes and seeding it down; it is thought that it might pay the lessee to have this work done at his own cost.
