
Sir:-

I have to request that you will call upon Mr. Constable Wilson to furnish you with his report and diary promptly at the expiration of each month, and that you will transmit them without delay to the Department.

This is essential in order that the Department may be kept regularly informed of Mr. Wilcox's whereabouts and of the work accomplished by him.

In January last Mr. Inspector Semmens was instructed by the Department to call upon Mr. Wilcox to proceed to Selkirk and Fort Alexander to endeavour to trace and bring to justice parties selling liquor to Indians. His report and diary for February have not yet been received, and up to the present date the Department has not been advised whether Mr. Wilcox has attended to the work referred to. If he has done so, you should ask him to forward his report before leaving for Portage la Prairie, as instructed in another communication.
