Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 13th instant, and the voucher rendered at \$75.00 which you submitted in favor of Mr. Murdoch R. McLeod for fence material purchased in connection with the school garden on the Middle River Reserve, I beg to say that the voucher in question is being paid. In future when the Department authorizes expenditure of this nature, it will be necessary when you submit the account for work done to have shown on the face thereof the time the men who worked were employed, and the rate of wages charged, etc. Should the work be done by contract or agreement, the contract, provided it is a written one, should be transmitted to the Department with the voucher. Kindly make a careful note of these instructions for your future guidance.
