I beg to transmit herewith cheque No. 263 for \$6352.75 being interest money available for distribution at the rate of \$20.00 per capita to Indians of the Cape Croker Band for the half year ended 31st March, 1919.

The following deductions have been made at the Department-

On account of loans	\$739.00
For Dr. Wigle	129.00
On account of sundries	179.25

The pay-lists, in which you are to account for the distribution are being sent to you under separate cover. Under No. 190 it is shown that there are three boys in the family. The pay-list for the fall of 1918 shows three girls in this family. The entries should be corrected. Under No. 197 you have shown one girl in the family, while the pay-list for the fall of 1918 shows a boy under this number. The necessary correction should be made.

\$6.00 has been retained from Peter Black, No. 136, for payment to Dr. Wigle, as there was not sufficient interest money at this Indian's credit last Spring to pay Dr. Wigle in full the amount which Black owed him.

I also enclose a statement of amounts retained from the Indians' interest money on loans. The necessary credits should be made by you in your loan book.
