Road through Malahat
Indian Reserve

Sir:-

On behalf of the Honourable H.C. Loughheed,
Minister of Public Works, I beg to submit a formal
application for the 1.12 acres of right-of-way re-
quired for road purposes through the above Reserve,
as shown on plans (one tracing and two linen prints),
sent you under separate cover. A description in trip-
licate is enclosed herewith.

As a result of several preliminary negotiations
with Mr. Ditchburn, to whom a copy of this letter is
being sent, the following tentative agreement has been
arrived at.--

1. Compensation to the extent of \$900.00 covering land
and improvements.
2. Both sides of road to be fenced by the Department,
with suitable gates provided at designated points.
3. In lieu of digging new wells, the Department is to
provide 500 feet of $\frac{1}{2}$ " galvanized pipe.

On receipt of your Department's acceptance of
the foregoing conditions, a cheque for the above amount
will be forwarded to Mr. Ditchburn.
