EXPLANATION.—The design of this Register is to record prescriptions and remedies that have been proved valuable, which would otherwise be irreparably lost, or necessitate the expense of a duplicate. A proper entry, in each case, will give the disease it is intended to relieve, the date when the Physician was called, or when the medicine was used, by whom prescribed, the required dose, the Druggist compounding it, and the prescription number.
