Proposed Form of Constitution & By-laws

Mr. F. H. Peters has given notice of certain amendments and additions that it is desirable to make in the constitution of the association, and these amendments and additions have had the consideration of the executive committee. The amendments chiefly concern the basis of representation which has been extended somewhat to meet present day requirements and a division of the old form of constitution into two partsconstitution on by-laws. In the by-laws have been incorporated rules for the direction of the committees of credentials and resolutions, with regard to which no definite course of procedure had been given previously. These amendments will be submitted to the delegates on the opening day of the convention at Lethbridge, Alberta, which has been set for July 28, and the following days.
