

Report of Clerk applying for certificate under Voters' Lists Act.

 To Wit : } do hereby certify as follows :

That I did, on the tenth day of August 1898, post up and for a period of thirty days next thereafter keep posted up, in a conspicuous place in my office at South Gower a true and correct printed copy of the Voters' List for the said Municipality of South Gower for 1898, made in pursuance of "The Voters' Lists Act," with the certificate required by section seven of the said Act endorsed thereon.

That I did also duly deliver and transmit by Registered Letter the required number of similar printed copies of the said Voters' List, with my certificate endorsed, to each and all of the persons entitled to the same under sections three and four of said Act.

That I did on the thirtieth day of August 1898, cause to be inserted in the newspaper call the "Daily Times" published in Brockville the notice required by section seven of the said Act.

That no person gave me nor did I receive any written notice of complaint and intention to apply to the Judge or Junior or acting Judge of the County Court of said United Counties of Ledds and Grenville in respect to the said Voters' List within thirty days after I, the said Clerk, had posted up the said List in my office, as directed by the provisions of the said Act.

And that to the best of my knowledge and belief, I have complied with the several requirements of the said Act, so as to entitle me to apply for certified copies under the eleventh section of the said Act; and I do hereby, in pursuance thereof, now apply to you the said Judge to certify three of the copies of the said List received by you as being the Revised List of Voters for the Municipality of the said Township of South Gower for the year of our Lord 1898.
