

Notice of Taxing Coſts, *Two Shillings and Six Pence.*

Drawing Notice of Exceptions to Bail Copy and Service, *Three Shillings and Six Pence.*

Every Continuance, *One Shilling.*

Every Diſcontinuance or Retraxit, *One Shilling.*

Attending, Ballotting, or ſtriking ſpecial Jury, *Ten Shillings.*

Attending taking every Inquiſition before Sheriff, *Ten Shillings.*

Making Bill of Coſts, *Two Shillings and ſix Pence.*

Attending to get ſame taxed, *Two Shillings and ſix Pence.*

Arguing a Demurrer ſpecial Verdict on Motion for new Trial or other ſpecial Motions, *Ten Shillings.*

Trial Fee, *Twenty Shillings.*

Drawing Common Rule in Ejeſtment, *Three Shillings.*

Copy, *Two Shillings.*

All other Rules and Copies, each *One Shilling.*

Every Supbœna, *Two Shillings.*

Every Ticket and Service, *Two Shillings and ſix Pence.*

Travel per Mile for Service, the ſame as to Sheriff.

Every Execution, Vend, Expres, Ven. Fa. Habeas Corpus, Writ of Error, Writ of Poſſeſſion, Rits. Habendo, and Writ of Enquiry, each *Six Shillings.*

Making up Iſſue every 90 Words, *Six Pence.*

Copy for Service, every 90 Words, *Six Pence.*

Making up Records, every 90 Words, *Six Pence.*

Engroſſing the ſame, every 90 Words, *Six Pence.*

All other Drafting and Copying neceſſary to be done by an Attorney in the Conducting of a Cauſe to be paid for, for every 90 Words, *Six Pence.*

Plaintiffs retracting or diſcontinuing their Suits without Leave of Court to pay Defendants their Fees.

II. *Be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforeſaid, That in all Cauſes wherein Judgment ſhall hereafter be given for the Plaintiff or Plaintiffs, all Fees which ſhall be paid, due, owing or payable by ſuch Plaintiff or Plaintiffs by Virtue of this Act ſhall be taxed againſt, and ſhall be paid by the Defendant or Defendants in ſuch Cauſe or Cauſes, and that in all Cauſes which ſhall be instituted and not proſecuted to final Judgment, or which ſhall be retracted or diſcontinued without Leave of the Court, where the ſame ſhall be instituted or the Conſent of the Defendant or wherein Judgment ſhall be given for the Defendant or Defendants all Fees Coſts, and Charges which ſhall be paid, due, owing or payable by ſuch Defendant or Defendants by Virtue of this Act, ſhall be taxed againſt and ſhall be paid by ſuch Plaintiff or Plaintiffs.*

None but ſworn Attornies to have Fees taxed, and only for Services actually done by them.

III. *Be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforeſaid, That none of the Fees by this Act allowed for Attornies ſhall be taxed for or allowed to any but ſworn Attornies regularly admitted into the Court, wherein any Cauſe ſhall be instituted or tryed, and in no Cauſe or Cauſes where-*
